The Thing is our flagship Shiraz at Sorby Adams. Sourced from fruit grown in low yielding hand pruned Barossa Shiraz vineyards dating back to the 1930s, these vines are some of the oldest in the region.

Only our best barrels make their way into this classic Barossa Shiraz showing why the old- vine fruit of the Barossa Valley and Eden Valley is so highly sought after. Spending 40 months in four year, air dried, fine grained French oak provides

sophisticated structure and tannins, whilst retaining fruit complexity and richness.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Colour: Deep inky magenta with a purple hue.

Aroma: This is magnificently fruited and gloriously expressed on the nose showing blackberry, spiced plum, chocolate tart, cake spice and cedar characters.

Palate: A sumptuous palate that is opulent and impressively weighted. The wine is powerfully graceful with a seamless flow to an impressively long engaging finish. Cellar: At its best: now to 2039.

Fruit: 100% Barossa Shiraz sourced from Eden Valley and Barossa Valley.
