Tristan & Isolde is a medieval tale of star-crossed lovers, knight Tristan and princess Isolde told from the 12th century.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

GI: Craneford (Eden Valley) and Ebenezer (Barossa Valley). **Colour:** deep cherry red with plum purple hue.

Aroma: blackberry and ripe raspberry with star anise and cashew characters. **Palate:** gratifying with succulent blackberry fruits, a full mouthfeel and excellent depth of flavour. Richness and velvety smooth tannins lead to a persistent finish.

Oak: 20% new French for 24 months. 4 year air dried oak. Francois Frere and Taransaud Coopers – tight grain. Drink now or cellar up to 2029.
